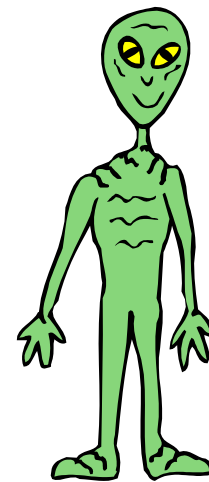


She led the way and the rest followed on. In the meantime, the alien climbed into the hole in the tree to discover what the friends had been doing inside.
